In accordance with section 124A(3) and (4) of the Education Reform Act 1988^(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Privy Council by Order dated 5th March 1993 made an instrument of government for the Ravensbourne College of Design and Communication, being a higher education corporation with respect to which Schedule 7 to the Act has effect.

Section 124A(3)(b) of the Act provides that the Privy Council may by Order modify an instrument of government of any such higher education corporation.

In accordance with the instrument of government, the Corporation have changed their name with the consent of the Privy Council.

Accordingly, Their Lordships, in exercise of the powers conferred on Them by section 124A(3)(b) of the Act, are pleased to modify the instrument of government in accordance with the provisions set out in the Schedule to this Order.
